

Grady-White 456

Luxury Sport Fishing Reimagined | STAFF REPORT

▶ GRADY-WHITE HAS BEEN A HOUSEHOLD NAME among discerning boaters for many years, having produced high-quality vessels since 1959. And while this revered manufacturer has become an icon known for its classic style, the Canyon 456 reminds us that Grady-White is still an industry leader. Blending modern craftsmanship with a timeless design, this center console is ideally suited for those who enjoy fishing in the lap of luxury.

Luxurious accoutrements aside, the Canyon 456 is a flat-out fishing machine. With a clean, open deck layout and innovative features throughout, this vessel performs ideally in a variety of offshore fisheries.

Among the many attractive attributes found on board is Grady-White's unique Sea Command Center, offering a variety of forward-thinking features. Not only is this area of the vessel aesthetically striking, but it also provides an array of electronics that centralize everything the vessel's operator might need. More specifically, CZone digital switching enables one-touch control of all systems including electrical, power, lighting and more. The four electronically adjustable, individual forward-facing seats at the Sea Command Center offer a surprising level of comfort for a center console, featur-

ing rich upholstery and stainless armrest supports along with fold-down footrests.

To ensure comfort while underway, this 45-footer's hull is designed for maximum smoothness, while additional features further enhance the vessel's seafaring abilities. Furthermore, Grady-White's unique SeaV2 hull design gives operators effortless control over the platform.

Owners also appreciate Yamaha's Helm Master system, making docking and maneuvering in tight quarters a breeze. The innovative Zipwake dynamic auto-leveling trim facilitates vessel operation as well, offering a user-friendly system that yields reliable results. The Canyon 456 boasts an impressive 14-foot beam, keeping passengers dry and helping the vessel maintain stability. However, Grady-White also includes a Seakeeper gyro stabilizer to ensure smooth

crossings through unforgiving conditions.

Upon reaching the fishing grounds, anglers have a host of fishing-friendly features at their disposal. Twin transom livewells are ideally placed for anglers working the cockpit, while a massive fishbox can be partitioned into three separate sections.

While having access to a cabin is something more commonly associated with much larger sportfish vessels, on the Canyon 456 the below deck salon is extremely comfortable and boasts several luxurious features including Corian countertops, refrigerator, wine cooler, sink, cooktop and more.

Powered by four Yamaha F350C outboards, the Canyon 456 cruises at roughly 31 mph and reaches a top end speed of around 55 mph. Ready to deliver the performance demanded by even the most discriminating offshore anglers, this platform is a classic combination of luxury and fishability not seen in many center consoles. *Grady-White Boats, gradywhite.com*
