Grady-White's most recent flagship center console — the [Canyon 456](#) — might garner the most attention from boat showgoers and media, but the company's previous flagship CC, the [Canyon 376](#), has certainly kept its luxurious luster. The 36-foot-7-inch SeaV2 V-hull features a 13-foot-two-inch beam that provides stability and loads of space above and belowdecks. Its 41-gallon livewell and optional additional 41-gallon well, cockpit side door, multiple insulated fish boxes and well-appointed rigging station satisfy the punch list for anglers.
