


Dual Conso

- A BIG DUAL CONSOLE LIKE GRADY-WHITE'S

Freedom 307 affords the weather protection of a cabin boat to the cockpit. But open the walkthrough and your crew can move forward to fish or just relax and enjoy the ride in the plush seating. Seats abutting the consoles allow reclining, and are deep enough so that crew seated here don't impede the skipper's view - an important aspect when shopping for a dual console. A table deploys for mealtimes, and an optional filler makes the bow a sun pad. With completely self-bailing cockpit and stowage, boats like the Freedom 307 are safe at sea and easy to hose off after a day of fishing, tubing or beachcombing.

The portside console houses a head and berth with five feet of headroom and a sink, plus it offers good light and ventilation.



Bow Lounge

Overboard draining, insulated stowage holds the catch of the day but will swallow party supplies or wakeboards just as well.

Enclosed Head and Berth

A solar-powered vent keeps the air fresh while a light box/skylight works in concert with the 12-volt lighting.

6 Helm

The helm is sprawling with room for the latest big-screen electronics. The seat's big enough for two and adjusts electrically. Inside is bulk stowage.

Wet Bar

Perfectly positioned for tying rigs or making sandwiches, there's also a trash can and sink and the top is fiddled to keep things in place. A refrigerator and grill are available.

Aft Cockpit

The electrically deployable port lounge adjoins the fold-down transom bench to create L-shape seating. Put the seats up to clear the decks for fishing, diving or swimming and playing. A freshwater shower and raw-water washdown keep things and people fresh.
