

# Boating with Dogs

10 tips for taking your canine Grady Buddy out for a great Grady day on the water

1. Keep plenty of **fresh drinking water** available. Puppy dog's gonna get thirsty!
2. **Walk your Grady Buddy** to make sure business is done before boarding.
3. **DOGGIE PFD!!** Give your pal a chance to get used to wearing the life jacket before getting on board.
4. Have your dog **practice swimming** in the life jacket before the first big outing!
5. Give your dog a chance to **get familiar with the boat** before you cast off.
6. **Protect paws.** Dogs absorb heat through their feet, and boat surfaces can get hot in the sun.
7. When fishing, keep lures, bait, knives, gaffs, and hooks **safely stowed and out of the way.** Bring a leash and be safe when the action hits! Dogs get excited just like you!
8. **Provide a shaded area.** Excessive exposure to the sun isn't good for animals.
9. **Keep your first outing short,** so your dog can get used to the boat's movement.
10. Don't forget the **treats and toys.** This will help your dog understand the boat is a safe place.
