





Grady-White's new Canyon 386 combines their celebrated SeaV2® hull with battlewagon fishing features and top-of-the-line luxury to deliver the ultimate boat for both fishing and cruising. Design ingenuity starts with the expansive layout that strategically positions four adjustable contoured helm chairs under the AV2 hardtop, behind the wraparound windshield. The ergonomic design of the sleek black helm has a large flush mount electronics area, push-button switches, and full maneuverability controls for the triple Yamaha 450 XTO engines. The rigging station doubles as an entertainment zone complete with Corian® countertop, freshwater sink, and an optional grill. The feature-rich bow includes a plush console lounge with folding armrests, electromechanically

adjustable backrests on the port and starboard seats, a sizable casting platform with cushions, and optional electrically adjustable table. Access the deluxe cabin with a separate head from the helm through a wide sliding door and step into a world of comfort. A well-appointed galley includes Corian counters, stainless steel sink, microwave, and refrigerator. A cherry dinette with removable base easily converts to a berth. Anglers will appreciate the huge cockpit with two 35-gallon livewells, a 291-quart digitally temperature-controlled insulated refrigerator/freezer fish box, two 149-quart bow fish boxes and plentiful rod holders and storage throughout. The 386 delivers extreme luxury packed in a rugged center console.
