The latest dual-console boat from Grady-White is multitalented.



THE POET ROBERT FROST SAID “freedom lies in being bold.” The all new 2016 Freedom 275 from Grady-White is bold indeed. The Freedom 275 dual console pushes the limits of versatility; it’s a multifunctional powerhouse with something for almost anyone who loves the water.

A few highlights include reconfigured deluxe seating, with an electric retractable chaise lounge seat. Extended, the aft-facing spotter’s seat is perfect for sunning, but when the boat’s a bit more crowded, retract it back and unfold the bench seat on the end of the tow line. Available features include a wet bar, complete with a Corian countertop, sink, fire extinguisher holder, storage/trash compartment, and an optional electric grill and refrigerator. The helm seating is a deluxe horizontally and vertically adjustable chair, but it can be upgraded to a plush cushioned contoured seat with flip-up bolster. The aft cockpit has been extended so there’s more room for activities, especially with that foldable bench.

When cruising, the Freedom has ample room in the bow area for sunbathers to relax in comfort and style. All cleats are the pull-up type, so guests won’t trip and lines won’t get snagged. Recessed cupholders and low-profile handrails all add up to a sleek, streamlined look. The Freedom 275 has a standard fiberglass hardtop supported by aluminum frames, protecting the captain from the elements.

The customizable dual console comes in one of five hull gelcoat colors or two paint colors. So the choice really is yours. The Freedom 275 will give you the *liberty* to be out to sea with all the amenities you want and need. *Grady-White, gradywhite.com*
